Five Little Seashells

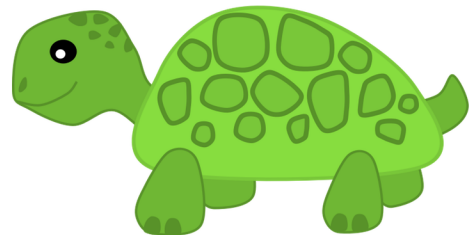

they all came to see the fun!

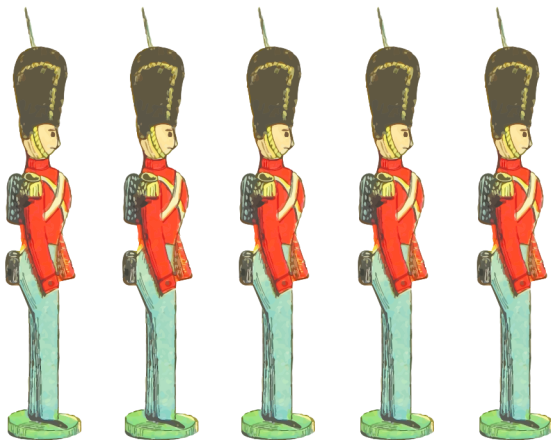


Finger Play Poems
