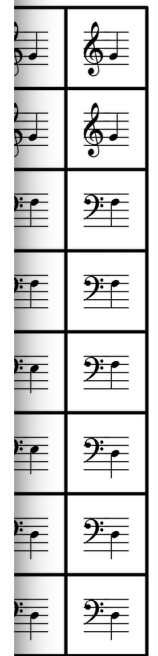

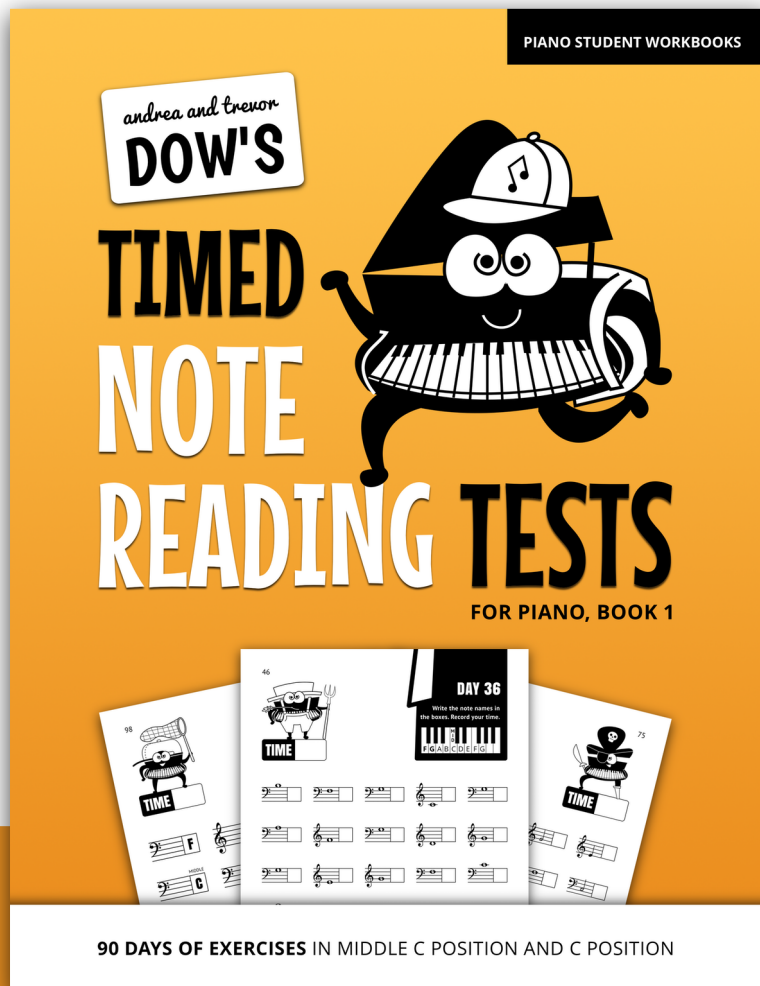


TIMED NOTE READING TESTS
