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INSTRUCTIONS

The music in this book is composed on the Wunder Staff using Wunder Dot Notation. Wunder Dots are finger number symbols that allow students to play pre-reading melodies before they learn traditional rhythmic notation (which is introduced in V. U. Level B). Wunder Dots placed on the RH section of the Wunder Staff are played with the right hand and Wunder Dots placed on the LH section of the Wunder Staff are played with the left hand.

Teacher Note: In each song, the teacher accompaniment is displayed in the gray boxes below the lines of the Wunder Staff. It contains suggested chords to support the student melody. To begin, the teacher accompaniment can be played as held chords. As students become more comfortable with the duet format, the chords can form the basis of an improvised accompaniment pattern.

Student Note: The fingers on your right hand (RH) are numbered 1 to 5, beginning with your thumb. The fingers on your left hand (LH) are also numbered 1 to 5, beginning with your thumb. The Keyboard Guide on each song page will show you where to place your fingers on the black keys.







Color the icing on each donut using the Crayon Guide. For example, if the finger number of the marked finger inside a donut is Right Hand 5, color the icing yellow.













