




Draw an X over the note below each platypus that matches the note name on its belly.






NOTE READING






SIGHT READING 2


Beginning at the START and ending at the FINISH, play the four measures of music that rest on the path. Next, use a colored crayon to draw a new fourmeasure path. Play again.






MYSTERY PICTURE

Color each square using the Crayon Guide. For example, if the note inside a square is G on the bass staff, color that square blue.








Draw an X over half an eggshell each day you practice with this book.
