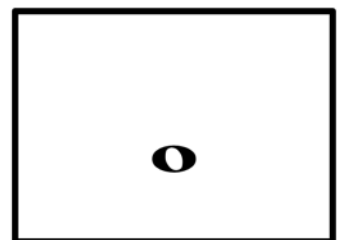
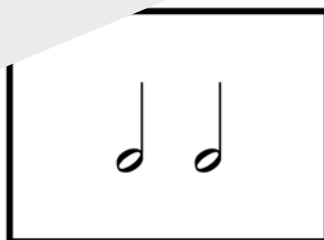
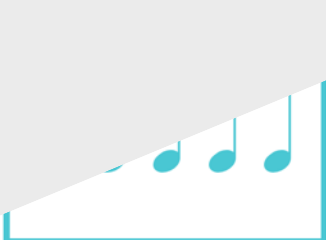


RHYTHM
