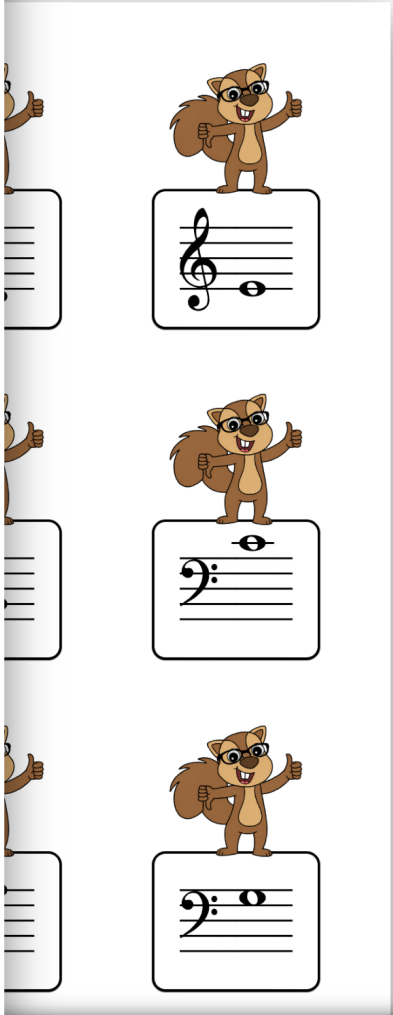




In this game, students silently predict whether the next note will be higher or lower... until a surprise moment sends them into a burst of hilarious, not-quiet-quiet chaos.

PRIMER PIANO CARD GAME



HOW TO PLAY

Game Objective

Musical Objective: To reinforce recognition of notes in Middle C Position.

Game Objective: To score more points than the opposing player.

Setup

1. Shuffle the 27 playing cards.
2. Place the deck face down in the center of the table.
3. Flip the top card face up beside the deck. This is the starting card.
4. Place a metal pot in the center of the table and give both players a spoon.
5. Place a piece of paper and a pencil nearby to record points.

How To Play

1. The first player looks at the face-up card and silently predicts whether the next note will be higher or lower on the staff by showing a thumbs up for higher or a thumbs down for lower.
2. Flip the next card from the deck.
3. If the prediction is correct, that player earns one point; if the prediction is incorrect, no point is awarded.

4. The flipped card stays face up and becomes the new comparison card for the next turn (Repeat Steps 1-3).
5. Players continue taking turns predicting higher or lower for each new card.

The Not Quite Quiet Rule

If the note on the flipped card corresponds to the same key as the note on the previous card (they match!), both players must race to repeatedly smash their spoon on the metal pot. (*Remember: middle C on the bass staff and middle C on the treble staff correspond to the SAME key and are a match.*)

The first player to smash the pot earns the point.

Important Rule

Both players must remain completely silent while the game is being played, except during the pot-smashing moment.

Ending the Game

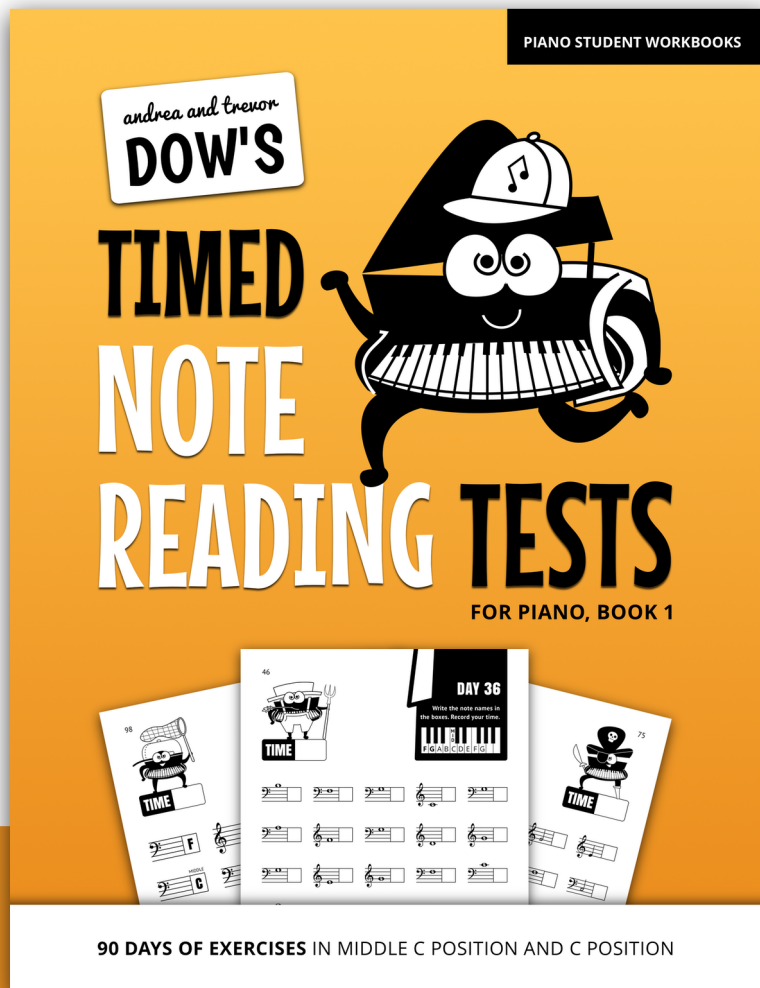
The game ends when all 27 cards have been used and the player with the most points wins.

TIMED NOTE READING TESTS

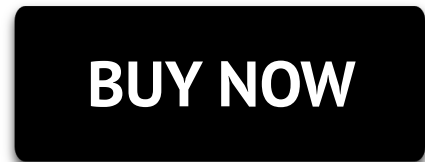
There are 10,080 minutes in a week. You teach each of your piano students for only 30 of these minutes.
